Backward Loop or E-wrap	2:17	stretchy, doesn't have bind off, good fro middle of row
Crochet Cast On	4:12	Chain edge on bottom, can be used as provisional cast on, matches standard bind off
Knitted Cast on	5:55	untwisted is looser, used in lace
Cable Cast On	8:28	good ropy edge, has right and wrong side, has purl variation, some stretch, good general cast on
Cable Cast On - Purl		
Long Tail Cast On	12:33	firm elastic edge,thumb yarn is on the bottom edge
Long Tail with coloured edge	16:35	
Old Noregian Cast On	18:00	nice edge, very stretchy
Ribbed Cast Ons	22:59	
Long Tail	23:30	
Cable Cast on Rib	28:00	best for K1P1, doesn't look good for K2P2,
Tubular K1P1	32:00	very stretchy

Invisible (K1P1)	45.55	
Invisible in the Round	53.00	
Invisible K2P2	55.27	
Decorative Cast Ons	59.00	
Channel Island	59.10	
Picot	1.06.12

Double Start	1.17.40	
Lidia's Braid	1.22.18	Variation of double start. Worked in two colours
Kihnu Troy	1.25.51	Makes braid look in 2 colours
Provisional Cast Ons	1.31.17	
Invisible Provisional Cast On	1.32.09	also called twisty wrap
Invisible Provisional with Circular Needle	1.36.41	leaves the stitches on a circular needle
Crochet Chain Provisional Cast On	1.38.17	
Circular Cast Ons	1.43.14	overview, avoiding the gap, placing markers
Turkish / Eastern Cast on	1.50.00	works for shawl tab start, works for round start
Judy's Magic Cast On	1.54.21	toe up socks, hats from top down
Emily Ocker's Cast On	1.59.05	Creates a closed centre start, doily type start, would be great for knitted animal arms, etc.
